

Mandaly jsou součástí každodenního života nás všech. Tvoříme je v rodinném kruhu, s přáteli, při práci a vůbec všude, kde se objevují pouta, prohlubují vztahy a něco silného se děje. Chtěl bych, aby si posluchači odnesli především radost, naději, uvědomění si a porozumění, jak je svět kolem nás bohatý a pestrý. Vědomí toho, že bohatství máme všichni na dosah ruky v každé chvíli, a pokud chceme, můžeme budovat mandaly nebo do nich vstupovat a obohacovat je kdykoliv se pro to rozhodneme.

Suita **Mandala** obsahuje v první části hlavní téma, které celou suitu objímá a vykresluje celek. Zbylé části, a tedy náplň této mandaly, pochází z buddhistické symboliky a představuje dokonalost a bohatství prostoru. Není důležité při poslechu detailně vědět, co jednotlivé symboly znamenají. Stačí se nechat unášet proudem hudby. Samozřejmě pokud posluchače tato tematika zajme, může lehce zapárat v knihách nebo si zajít na buddhistickou přednášku, kde se mu dostane uspokojivého vysvětlení.

Mandalas are a part of everyday life for all of us. Metaphorically, we create them in the family circle, with friends, at work and everywhere where bonds appear, relationships deepen and something powerful happens. I would like the listeners to take away joy, hope, awareness and understanding of how rich and colorful the world around us is. This awareness is the belief that we all have wealth at our fingertips at any moment and if we want, we can build Mandalas, or enter them and enrich them whenever we decide to do so.

The **Mandala** suite contains the main theme in the first part, which embraces the entire suite and depicts the whole. The remaining parts and therefore the content of this specific Mandala comes from Buddhist symbolism and represents the perfection and richness of space. It is not important to know in detail what the individual symbols mean when listening – just let yourself be carried away by the flow of music. Of course, if the listener is interested in this topic, he can easily search in books or go to a Buddhist lecture, where he will get a satisfactory explanation.
